The Philadelphia Sketch Club (PSC) in collaboration with the Willingboro Art Alliance (WAA) will be holding a joint show called "City Meets Country". This show will be featuring artwork which represents urban or rural life.

The first 40 PSC members who respond will be in both shows. You can respond by sending your intention to show to dfascenda@comcast.net or call 609 859-0607 and leave a message. You MUST be registered in order to bring your art work for these special shows.

Each of the 40 PSC artists will submit two pieces of art work. Both of the art works will be delivered to PSC. One of the pieces will remain at the Philadelphia Sketch Club (PSC); and one piece will be taken to the Smithville Annex Gallery in NJ – the artist will indicate where each piece will be hung by checking the boxes below. The WAA members will also be submitting pieces of art work and 40 of their pieces of art will be in the Smithville show as well as 40 pieces in PSC Gallery. This is an exciting opportunity to be able to show in Philadelphia and in New Jersey.

Works Eligible: The two works can be any 2-D medium, no nudes. Maximum framed size 40 inches in any direction. All work must be wired and ready for hanging. No clip frames. Non-suitable pieces will be rejected.

Liability: All submitted work will be handled with care, however, the PSC and WAA assumes no liability for loss or damage. Untimely pick-up is subject to storage charges.

Sales: The PSC Gallery will be open on Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays from 1 to 5 pm for the duration of the exhibition. A sales attendant will be on duty. Prices should include a 25% commission for the Philadelphia Sketch Club.

Directions to Smithville, NJ, 803 Smithville Road, Eastampton, NJ 08060

From Ben Franklin Bridge • Take Route 30 and head east on Route 38 • From intersection of Route 541 and Route 38: heading East on Route 38, travel 2.9 miles and turn left onto Smithville Road. • Main park entrance will be down on the left, off of Meade Lane.

From Philadelphia Bridges Walt Whitman Bridge • After crossing the bridge, take Route 295 North to Exit 47A – Mt Holly Route 541 South. • Take Route 541 South to Woodlane Road (Route 630). • Take jug handle to make a left onto Woodlane Road. • Take Woodlane Road to Smithville Road. • Make right onto Smithville Road. • Take Smithville Road through one stop sign (blinking red light) at Powell Road. • Main park entrance is at Meade Lane on right.

From Tacony Palmyra or Betsy Ross Bridges • Follow Route 73 South to Route 295 North. • See directions "From Route 295" above.

From Burlington Bristol Bridge • Follow Route 130 North. At 3rd light make a right onto Route 541 East. • See directions "From Route 295" above.

From NJ Turnpike/PA Turnpike • Take PA/NJ Turnpike Bridge to NJ Turnpike South. • Follow the NJ Turnpike to Exit 5. • At light at the end of the exit ramp turn right onto Route 541 South. • Take Route 541 South to Woodlane Road (Route 630). • Take jug handle to make a left onto Woodlane Road. • Take Woodlane Road to Smithville Road. • Make right onto Smithville Road. • Take Smithville Road through one stop sign (blinking red light) at Powell Road. • Main park entrance is at Meade Lane on right.

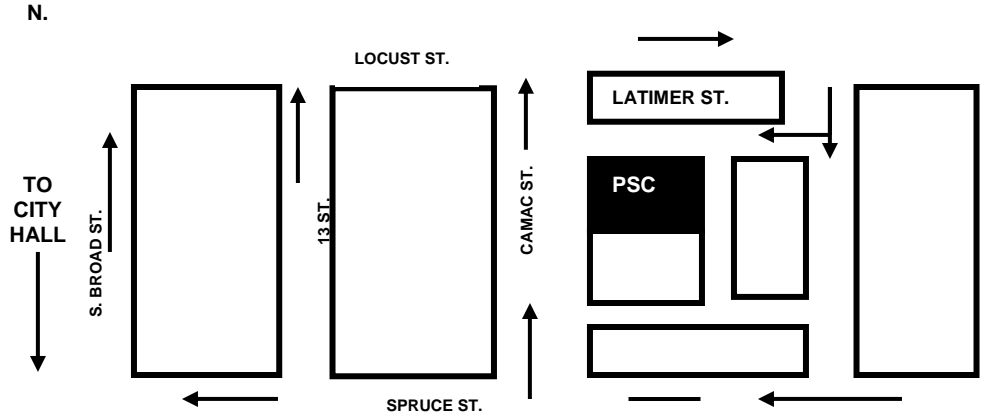
