Work must be delivered on Friday, May 29th 1- 5 PM and Saturday, May 30th from 12 PM to 5 PM.

WORKS ELIGIBLE:

This is an open, juried competition for illustration work in any media completed during the last 5 years. All work must be original and not previously shown at the PSC. Work must be framed and wired for hanging. Clip frames are not allowed. Size is limited to 40" in either direction including frame. High quality prints will be accepted in the case of digitally created work only. Works may be offered for sale.

CATEGORIES:

Editorial: Works commissioned by newspapers or magazines, medical or scientific publications, or online magazines.
Advertising and Institutional: Works appearing in advertisements in newspapers, magazines, point of purchase and packaging illustration, movie or theater posters, annual reports calendars, corporate projects, government service projects, greeting cards, in-house publications, philatelic work and collectibles.
Book: All illustrations commissioned for use inside or on the covers of hardbound and paperback books, includ-

ing fiction, non-fiction, comic books, young adult, children's and textbooks.

Self Promotional and Uncommissioned:

Works created to showcase an illustrator's ability and styles to potential clients.

Student: Any work completed as an assignment during the 2008-09 academic year by a student enrolled in a college-level illustration course.

JURORS: George Thompson, illustrator and fine artist, and Glenn Zimmer, illustrator and Art Director for ASI, Inc. Juror's results will be mailed and/or e-mailed. Please do not call for results.

ENTRY FEES: Sketch Club members: \$12.00 for one entry, \$20.00 for two; Non-members: \$15.00 for one entry, \$25.00 for two. Fees are not refundable.

AWARDS: Cash awards in each category.

RECEPTION: Artists and patrons are invited to attend the opening reception on Sunday, June 14th from 2-4 PM. Awards will be presented at 3 PM.

SALES: With the exception of holidays, the Sketch Club will be open Mon., Wed., Fri., Sat.

and Sun. from 1-5 PM. Sales commission is 25%.

DELIVERY: No slides or commercial shipments will be accepted. All works must be delivered by hand to the Sketch Club at 235 South Camac St. Refer to calendar for dates. To accommodate illustrators outside of Philadelphia, work may be delivered to sites identified on the reverse of the identification card by appointment only. Works stored at owner's risk.
PICK UP: Refer to calendar. Work not removed on these days may be picked up by appointment only. Work stored at owners risk for a fee of \$2 per day.

LIABILITY: Work will be handled with care, but the PSC cannot be responsible for loss or damage.

AGREEMENT: Entering work in this show shall imply an agreement by the artist with all conditions set forth. Jurors shall have the sole and final decision regarding awards.

JURORS:

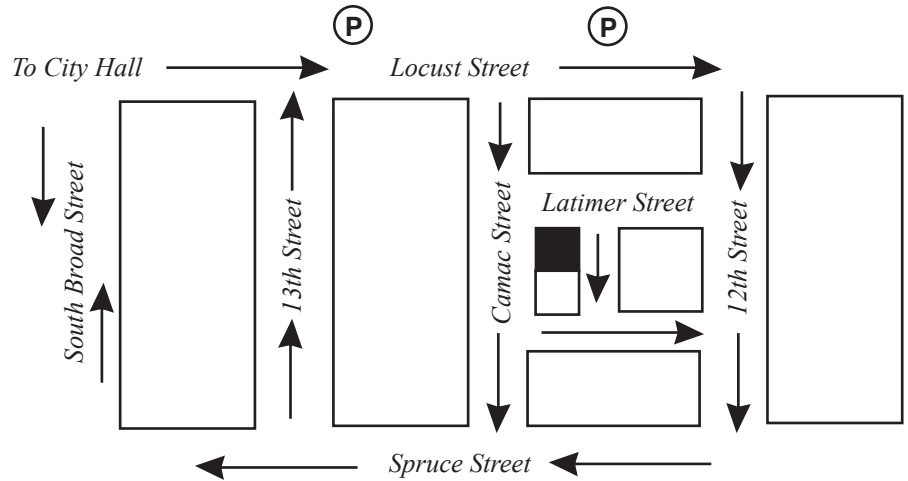

The Philadelphia Sketch Club was formed in 1860 by six "Bohemian" students from the Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Arts who sought illustration and design opportunities not available at the Academy. Some of the prominent illustrators who have since been members include A.B. Frost, Howard Chandler Christy, and N.C. Wyeth.
