

The **Philadelphia Sketch Club** is sponsoring its first juried exhibition on the theme of flowers to coincide with the annual Philadelphia Flower Show hosted by the Horticultural Society of Philadelphia.

**WORKS ELIGIBLE:** This is an open, juried competition for 2 or 3 dimensional works of art on the theme of flowers. All submissions must be wired for hanging. Size is limited to 40" in width including frame and under 30 lbs. (Clip frames are not allowed.) There is a maximum of two submissions per person and all work must be for sale. Work must be original and not previously shown at the PSC.

**AWARDS:** Both cash and merchandise awards will be made.

**DIRECTIONS FOR ENTRY FORMS:** *Please Print.* For each entry, identically fill out forms A & B. Attach form A to the back of your work. Bring your work, form B and your entry fee to the Sketch Club with your stamped notification card. *Do not fill in number spaces; this will be done at the club.*



**CALENDAR**

- MARCH 11-12:** Delivery of work 11 a.m. -4 p.m.
- MARCH 13-14:** Jury makes selections
- MARCH 13:** Notification begins
- MARCH 17 & 18** Works not accepted are to be picked up at PSC 11 a.m.-4 p.m.
- MARCH 19:** Opening reception and awards ceremony 2-5 p.m. Awards at 4 p.m.
- APRIL 2:** Show closes
- APRIL 2, 7-8:** Pick up Work 11 a.m.- 4p.m.

**ENTRY FEES:** Two works may be submitted for a fee of \$20. The fee for one work is \$12. For active PSC members, fees are \$15 for two and \$10 for one submission. Fees are not refundable.

**SALES:** With the exception of holidays, the PSC will be open Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays and weekends from 1 to 5 p.m. Sales commission is 25%.

**LIABILITY:** Work will be handled with care, but the PSC cannot be responsible for loss or damage. Work not picked up within 30 days after the pick up date may be auctioned to benefit the club.

**AGREEMENT:** Entering work in this show shall imply an agreement by the artist with all conditions set forth in this prospectus. Jurors shall have the sole and final decision regarding prizes and awards.

**DELIVERY AND PICK UP:** All works must be delivered in person. No slides, no shipments. Work must be delivered to the PSC at 235 South Camac Street from 11 a.m to 4 p.m. on March 11 and 12.

**PICK UP:** Unaccepted works must be picked up on March 17 and 18 at the PSC between 11 a.m. and 4 p.m. Work cannot be picked up on the day of reception. Accepted works must be picked up at the PSC on April 2, 7 or 8 between 11 a.m. and 4 p.m. Work not removed on these days may be picked up by appointment only. Work not picked up on the scheduled pick up days will be stored at the owner's risk for a fee of \$2.00 per day, per piece. 30 days after the pick up date, the work may be auctioned to benefit the club.

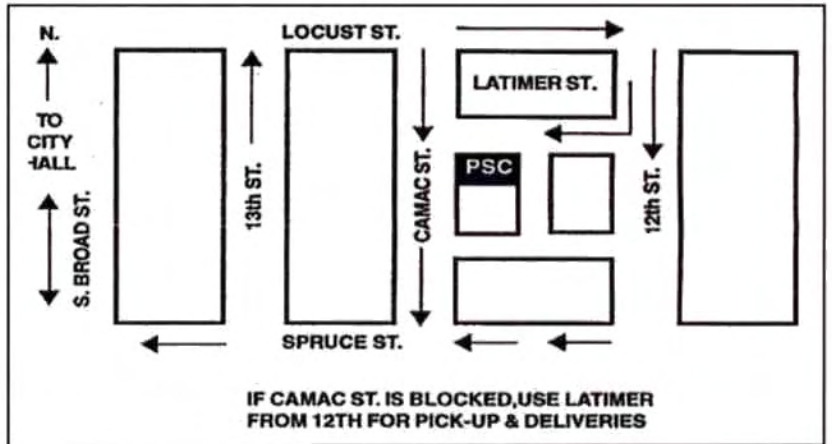
