All work must be original and not previously shown at PSC. Works must be under glass. Work must be framed and wired for hanging. (Clip frames not allowed). Size is limited to 40" in either direction including frame. All work must be for sale.

Artists and patrons are invited to attend the opening reception on Sunday, January 14 from 2-5 pm. Awards will be presented at 4 pm. Work cannot be picked up until the end of the show.

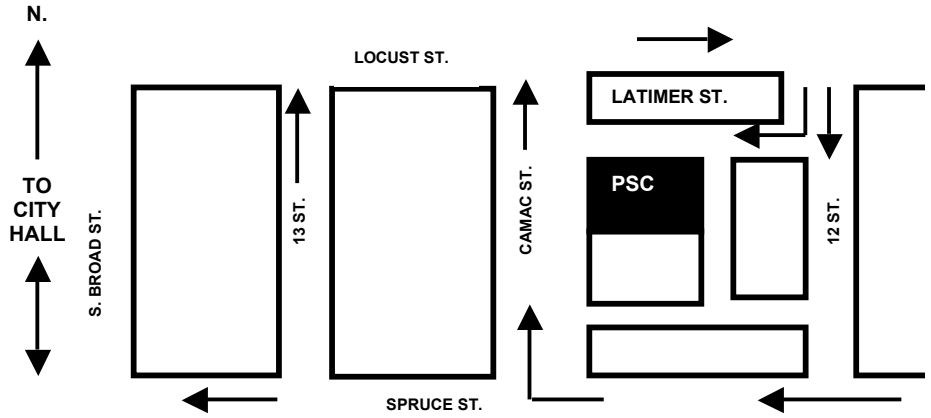
